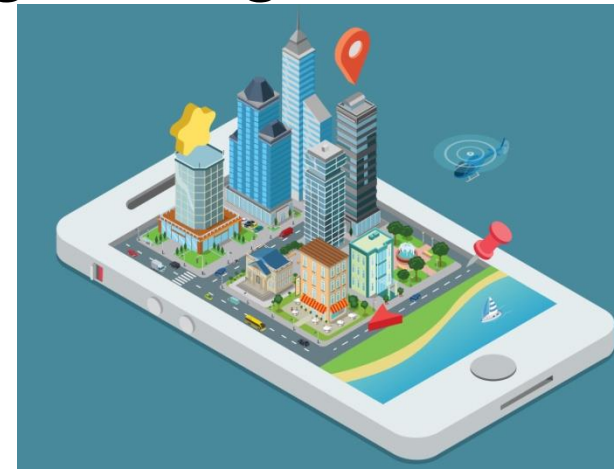

What is the difference between smart and intelligent city?

Smart city would cover more aspects than an intelligent one and in this case could be considered a further stage of urban development after incorporating intelligence into city functions.
